Elements of the course:

Students will be expected to carry out independent study alongside a mixture of lectures, discussion and group work. Guest speakers will provide students with access to professionals from a wide range of sectors within the health and social care sector.

Students will be expected to plan and set up a community event as part of this course. A trip to London is arranged annually.

Where could it take me?

This qualification will provide students with the opportunity to apply for university and pursue a career as a nurse, midwife, social worker, special educational needs teacher, care work and many more professions within the health and social care sector.

Entry Requirements

Assessment:

The Level 3 Diploma (equivalent to two A-Levels) and Extended Diploma (equivalent to three A-Levels) is assessed via a combination of externally and internally assessed units comprising of reports, examinations, practical tasks and presentations.

Minimum:

Standard Entry Requirements: 5 GCSE's at a grade 4 or above.

Special Requirements:

Students should be able to provide evidence that they are competing or participating regularly in their chosen sport or be engaging in an active and healthy lifestyle.
