


Thank you for your interest in Callington Community College Sixth Form.

We pride ourselves on our strong relationships with students and the strong sense of community that exists across the College. Sixth Form Transition



It is often a challenge for young people to make the transition from KS4 to KS5. There are a number of academic, personal and social changes that can occur, which Callington Community College Sixth Form recognises, ensuring that appropriate support and guidance is put in place to support all our learners.

Students who apply to our Sixth Form will be interviewed as part of the application process and invited to participate in an induction programme. This provides the students with the opportunity to

meet their new tutor, attend subject classes and engage in a number of workshops promoting strategies and opportunities to help students succeed in Post-16 education.

Students will also attend a number of workshops within the Autumn term. These carefully planned workshops aim to help students develop a greater understanding of the expectations of Sixth Form life, but also to develop the skills, mindset and attributes needed to fulfil their potential.



Pastoral Care and Support



Callington Community College Sixth Form prides itself on the care and support it provides each and every student. A team of highly experienced and knowledgeable Sixth Form tutors provide daily contact with all students through the tutor programme, which includes regular individual students interviews (ISIs), academic and personal mentoring and being the first port of call for both students and parents or carers regarding any concerns.

This is further supported by a programme where Sixth Form students continue to be supported through external organisations, assemblies, careers advice and guidance, workshops and events to continue to support each and every student further.

The Sixth Form has its own dedicated safeguarding officer and full time administrator. In addition, students are able to access the school counsellor and a number of external medical and health and wellbeing agencies, if further support is needed. There is also a 16-19 bursary available to those individuals that are eligible to apply.



Academic Outcomes



To enable our Sixth Form students to reach their full potential, we offer a wide range of A level courses and BTEC Level 3 courses. Teaching at Post-16 is a real strength in the college and subjects are well resourced. Naturally, this leads to excellent results and high aspirations for our students. Subject teachers form excellent working relationships with their students based on mutual respect and trust, which has a significant and positive impact on individual outcomes.

In addition to excellent teaching and learning, students are supported through a tutor programme which focuses on

developing individuals' study skills and personal mindset. This programme is designed to enable students to grow in confidence and successfully navigate the challenges of Level 3 study.

In the last set of validated results (2018/2019), Sixth Form students made more progress, on average, than students across England who got similar results at the end of Key Stage 4. The August A Level results saw 98.4% of students successfully pass their A levels, with 38.3% achieving the highest grades of A* - B. All vocational students successfully passed their qualifications, with students averaging a Distinction grade.
