

Network Security Specialists

We gather intelligence and explore new opportunities in internet technologies to stay one step ahead of computer criminals and terrorists. Our teams invent new solutions, advance technologies and constantly challenge what's possible. Join us and you'll enjoy the scope to find innovative, hands-on solutions to meet our immediate business needs, while also sustaining our long-term capabilities.

THE RECRUITMENT PROCESS.

Because of the nature of our work, we have stricter requirements in terms of nationality, residency and security than other Civil Service departments.

Our vetting process is rigorous, but fair, and is designed to clear you for Developed Vetting Security Clearance, which enables you to work with the security services. The process involves looking into your character, family history and personal circumstances, and to qualify, you must be over 18. The full vetting process can take up to nine months depending on circumstances, but you'll understand why it's so thorough when you join us.

If you apply to join us you should only discuss your application with your parents, siblings and partner.
