GCSE and A Level Results 2023	The College was asked to share highlights and lowlights from the Summer. The College shared that there had indeed been some successes, most notably in languages, but results had decreased in comparison to 2022 and were disappointed with outcomes broadly. Whilst it is acknowledged that comparisons with 2019 are the only real comparable data (for which the College had improved the number of students gaining 5s in English and Maths by 7%), the College felt that many students should have performed better and analysis had yielded that attendance, behaviour and incompletion of homework was a significant factor. The College shared its steps to improve which were broadly acknowledged and known – An increased presence in lessons, an increased expectation and sanctions for Yr 11 students who do not complete home learning.	The College is monitoring lessons more frequently and has introduced late detentions and homework sanctions to ensure success is not minimised by effort.
