

Callington Community College Images Consent (Student 16+)



There are sometimes occasions when we wish to take photographs or make video recordings of students at our College. Sometimes this is for strictly educational purposes and on other occasions it may be for other purposes ancillary to the running of the College (e.g. taking photographs for use in the College's brochure and on the College and Trust's websites). Similarly, there are occasions when the local press visit the College to record particular College events (e.g. College productions) and they may wish to publish photographs in newspapers or use recordings on television when reporting these events.

In order to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation, the College needs your consent before taking photographs or making video recordings for purposes which are not part of its core activities. We would therefore be grateful if you could answer the questions overleaf, sign each section, date the form and return it to the College as soon as possible.

Conditions of Consent

- 1. An Images Consent database is kept in College showing preferences with regard to use of a student's image and name (as expressed on the Images Consent Form). Where a consent form is not held for a student, the College will not use their image.
- 2. The database will be consulted before images or names are used for any publicity purpose.
- 3. If consent has been given for all purposes, no further consent will be sought.
- 4. If consent has not been given, the student may be approached for permission to use their image either one time only, or in group photos, or in all future photos. The database will be updated accordingly.
- 5. Students over the age of 16 will be asked to give or withhold permission for their image to be used.
- 6. Where possible publishing close up or individual photographs of students will be avoided. The College's preference is to publish class, team or group images of students. The aim is to strike a balance between protecting students' identities and giving them due credit for their achievements.
- 7. Photographs published on the website, or elsewhere that include students will be selected carefully and will comply with good practice guidance on the use of such images.
- 8. Names of students may be used in Press Releases and on the College and Trust websites as specified in the Images Consent database. However there may be occasions when the Press send a photographer to the College and take pictures and names directly from students (e.g. exam results day). The College will make every attempt to control this, but the student should be aware whether they have agreed to this.
- 9. Names will only be used in publicity where individual students are being congratulated on their achievements. Every attempt will be made to avoid identifying pictured students by name.
- 10. At any time, a student has the right to withdraw any or all consent previously given. This removal of consent will be actioned by the College without reasonable delay upon the submission of a signed 'Withdrawal from Consent' form, available on the College's website.
