Mis (Germanic) – wrong or false

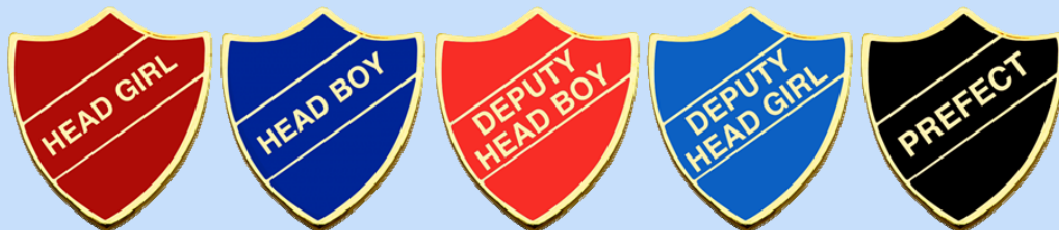
